AWARD CATEGORIES

Volunteer of the Year

The Equine Association of the Yukon Volunteer of the Year Award recognizes an outstanding volunteer who has contributed to equestrian sport and the horse industry. Volunteer service may include years of participation, administration, contribution, innovation, or the advancement of equestrian sport. This Individual has also worked tirelessly to support equestrian events and has had a notable impact on the horse community.

Youth Sportsmanship Award

The EAY Youth Sportsmanship Award is presented to an EAY Junior member who displays exemplary sportsmanlike conduct while competing and interacting with other competitors and officials (including judges, ring stewards and competition committees); working in the stabling areas; caring for their horse; and associating with the general public.

Athlete of the Year

This award has been split into two categories to recognize athletes in both Junior and Senior categories. Equestrian disciplines may include Western, Dressage, Hunters, Jumpers, Eventing, Rodeo and Barrel Racing, Driving, Vaulting, and Endurance.

Senior Athlete: This award recognizes outstanding athletic performance by an athlete 18 years of age or older, competing in a recognized equestrian discipline. This individual **MUST** be a member of the Equine Association of the Yukon in good standing to be nominated.

Junior Athlete: This award recognizes outstanding athletic performance by an athlete 17 years of age or younger, competing in a recognized equestrian discipline. This individual **MUST** be a member of the Equine Association of the Yukon in good standing to be nominated.

Horse of the Year

This award recognizes a Yukon horse. It can be awarded to a competitive horse that has achieved a high level of success in competition or a horse that is used in any form of noncompetitive activity (i.e. therapeutic riding).
